

Making the Most of Your Tutoring Time

Here are some suggestions for you to take into consideration when you come to tutoring.

- 1) Come prepared with your book, notes, and any old assignments that you want to go over. If you don't understand a part of your notes or homework, put a checkmark or star near that part so you can find it quickly during the session.**
- 2) Come to every session every week. If you have completed your homework, don't have a test or quiz to study for, or don't have any stray questions for me then we can always work ahead. (Find out from your teacher in advance what you will be doing.)**
- 3) Come to the session with an open mind. If you learned something difficult in class that day, don't have the "I give up" attitude. Many times that tutoring session is just what you need to clarify or re-learn the material.**
- 4) Have all homework or study sheets completed before you come to your session. Our time is not as efficient when I am watching you do your homework. If you come with completed work, I can check what you have done, answer any questions, or we can work ahead.**
- 5) Come to your session even if you don't have school that day or are on a break. This is the perfect opportunity to catch up, clarify, practice, or look at what will be coming up. In other words, there is always something to do!**
- 6) Read all handouts given to you. Keep these papers in a handy spot and look them over when you have a few moments.**
